What: A dynamic 18-hour workshop introducing the core principles and applications of Asset-Based Community Development (ABCD) in the context of local communities. Presentations and discussions will occur in the context of current conversations about equity and social justice and will enable participants to think deeper about responses to these challenges.

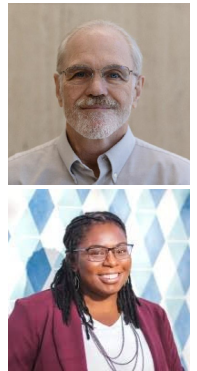

- How might ABCD address income and race disparity?
- What does it take to create a healthy community?
