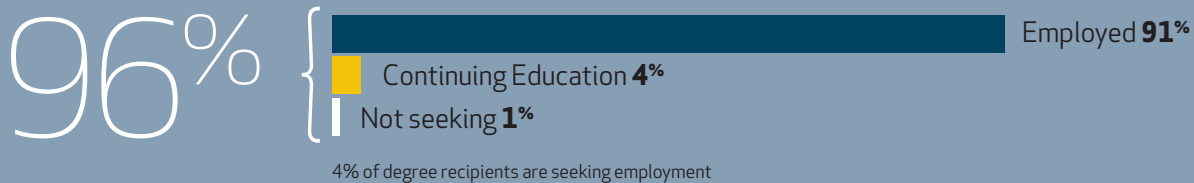

Graduate Degree Recipients



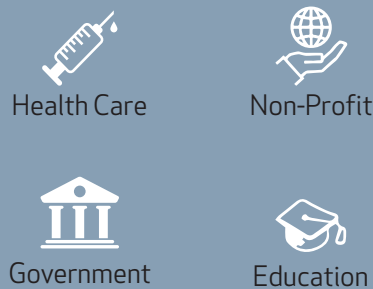
Overall outcomes for 2017 LAS graduate degree recipients **improved by 3 percentage points**, led by an **increase of 22 percentage points** in the outcomes rate for social work graduates and a **10 percentage point increase** for sociology graduates.

Employment Details

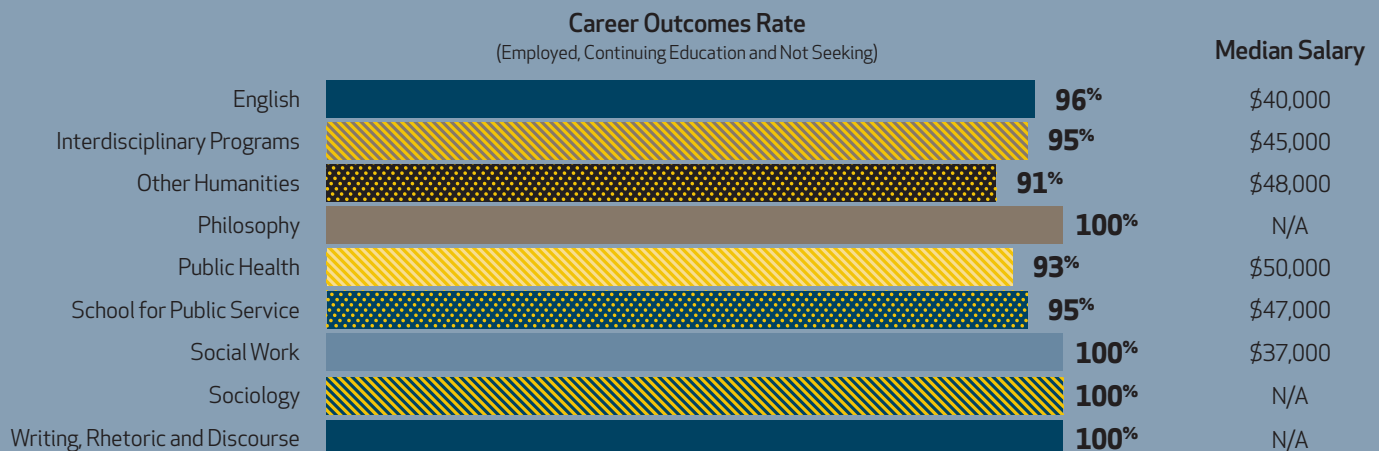
85% of employed graduates are in a job related to their degree
