

ALLSTATE DEPAUL UNIVERSITY MBA PROGRAM

DePaul University's Kellstadt Graduate School of Business (KGSB) is partnering with Allstate to offer the DePaul MBA, starting in September 2018. To earn the MBA, students will complete all of the 11 required core courses and seven additional courses with a concentration in management.

The program will meet every other week on Saturdays at DePaul University's loop campus (1 E. Jackson, Chicago) from 8:45-4:30 p.m. and online on off weeks. Students will be able to complete the degree in 24 months.

COST

DePaul provides a **25 percent tuition discount** for Allstate employees in the MBA program.

Employees with undergraduate business degrees may be eligible for course waivers, further lowering the tuition cost.

The Allstate-DePaul discount cannot be combined with any other DePaul scholarship or discount, or DePaul financial aid award. Loans, federal and state grants, and non-DePaul scholarships are available as well as flexible payment option plans, to those who qualify. Your employer tuition reimbursement benefit enables you to apply for DePaul's deferred payment plan. A small tuition increase may occur for all MBA students, Allstate students included, in the upcoming academic years.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- **No GMAT test, letters of recommendation or essay required for the MBA program**
- Online graduate application (go.depaul.edu/apply); the application fee will be waived for all Allstate applicants
- Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended, one of which must be from a regionally accredited college or university
- Résumé

- An online graduate application, which can be found at go.depaul.edu/apply.
- Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended, one of which must show the conferral of a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university.
