The Master of Arts Program in Applied Professional Studies (MAAPS) from the School of Continuing and Professional Studies (SCPS) serves adults interested in a graduate degree comprised of cutting-edge professional competences grounded in a foundation of strategic planning, applied inquiry, and liberal arts-based soft skill development in a multi-disciplinary cohort setting.

TRACKS

- Organizational Leadership—for students interested in learning to leverage their existing business skills and influence the direction
 of their organizations and industries.
- Educating Adults—for students who want to deepen their knowledge in the field of educating adults in professional, academic or community settings.
- Social Change— for students whose practice involves leading effective social change in communities and organizations.

PROGRAM OUTCOMES

Students who complete the MAAPS common curriculum plus their track demonstrate the following learning outcomes:

- Demonstrate advanced knowledge in their areas of professional study
- Cultivate a regular practice of reflection on their professional practice
- Engage methods of inquiry to improve practice in their area of study
- Anticipate, adapt and engage with emerging issues in their area of study and practice
- Broaden professional networks

PROGRAM FEATURES

- Students complete their degree entirely in an online format.
- Students benefit from the support of a dedicated academic advisor.
- Students may earn credit for professional and life experience through Prior Learning Assessment.
- Students engage with fellow students—working professionals with diverse jobs, experiences, and interests.

COST

The AY 2024-25 tuition is \$723 per credit hour and the program is 52 credit hours. FOP discounts can apply.

If you qualify, loans, federal and state grants, and DePaul scholarships may be available, along with flexible payment options. Students must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (fafsa.ed.gov). If you have employer tuition reimbursement benefits you can apply for DePaul's deferred tuition payment plan.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale from previous school
