The awards are announced to the University community and presented at the annual Academic Convocation each September.

FAQs

Why this award?

At DePaul, academic advisors are in different offices as they live out the values of their profession – and the values of the University – in many ways every day. Think about the advisor at DePaul who has had an impact on making your DePaul experience a success, then make sure she/he/they is recognized. This kind of recognition follows in the spirit of other DePaul teaching and service awards.

Who can nominate for this award?

Any undergraduate and graduate student, a staff member, or a faculty member can nominate an academic advisor for the academic advising award.

Who is eligible to receive the award?

Any faculty or staff member who serves as an academic advisor and has worked at DePaul University for at least one year (and, of course, whom you feel provides excellent academic advising).

Who decides the award recipients?

The selection committee consisting of a member of Staff Council, a member of Faculty Council, a member of the Student Government Association, the preceding year recipients, Associate Provost for Academic Affairs and a member of the DePaul Academic Advising Network executive board will select the award recipients from the eligible pool of nominees. All nominations are anonymized during the selection process.

When should I submit my nomination? In 2023, nominations March 6 through March 24.

When will I know the results of my nomination?

Award recipients will be announced in the summer, and award presentations will occur during the annual Academic Convocation each September.
