### II. Project Update

Research Question 1) What are college-level foreign language educators' perceptions about online language teaching including its values, their self-confidence in and knowledge about online language teaching, and student readiness for online language teaching after more than one year's emergency remote language teaching? 2) How has more than one year of emergency remote teaching impacted college-level foreign language educators' teaching practices upon return to campus?

Progress Report: We have completed data collection of the project and some preliminary data analyses.

Impact: The findings of this research project will help the field of foreign language education understand how the prolonged remote teaching impacted college-level foreign language educators' knowledge and perceptions of online language teaching changes.

Dissemination: We will be presenting the findings at two national conferences, one at the American Council for Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) annual convention in November 2022, the other at the American Association for Applied Linguistics (AAAL) annual convention in March 2023. We are currently drafting one book chapter and one journal article.
